Isaiah can seem formidable, full of unpronounceable names and unfamiliar places. Yet it is often considered to be the deepest, richest, and most theologically significant book in the Old Testament. It is, without question, an insightful affirmation of the character and nature of God. Across the 66 chapters, Isaiah enhances our understanding of God while pointing forward to the coming of Christ and the salvation of humanity.
