Primary Responsibilities

- Collaborate with the student ministry team as well as the Associate Pastor of Youth and Young Adults to establish and implement goals by training and deploying volunteer leaders
- Routinely evaluate the Student Ministry program in conjunction with the Student Ministers and Associate Pastor of Youth and Young Adults for the purpose of cultivating a strong community of disciples and disciple-makers.
- Share in a bold and faithful vision for student ministry, operating within the umbrella of the collaborative youth program
- Share Sunday School responsibilities with the other student ministers, including teaching, worship and administration
- Be responsible for Wednesday evening programming, which includes teaching, worship, and administration
- Participate in one-on-one mentoring of senior and junior high students, as needed
- Serve as a collegial team member as a part of the FPC Staff
- Manage a high volume of communication via email and phone

Specific Emphasis Areas:

- Responsible for overall success of senior high ministry (grades nine through twelve)
 - (a) Work in conjunction with student ministers to provide a faithful and relevant senior high ministry that aligns with the vision and mission of First Presbyterian Church.
- Plan, organize, and execute senior high events including mission trips, retreats, and local events.
- Keeping all Roots social media platforms engaging, updated, and relevant
- Maintain a discipling culture that connects senior high students with junior high students and adults
- Regularly help plan and teach lessons throughout the year in conjunction with the other student ministers

Personal Qualifications:

- Relational and caring with a good knowledge of the Bible
- Commitment to the theological distinctives of the Reformed Faith within the framework of both First Presbyterian Church and ECO's polity and procedures
- Friendly, approachable, energetic, positive personality
- Strong relational and interpersonal skills, able to connect with students (6th -12th grades)
